



# Construction and Demolition Recycling Training and Accreditation

This day-long training provides the skills to develop, manage, monitor, document and promote a successful recycling program for construction and demolition debris. Participants receive three year Accreditation in Construction Waste Recycling and training to obtain LEED construction waste management points.

This **C&D Recycling Training program is eligible for continuing education credits for LEED Accredited Professionals.** Any LEED Professional who has taken an approved course after July 8, 2009 should save their 'certificate of completion' for that course as verification for credit reporting.
