Warrantied Subsurface Sewage Treatment System Products

Water Quality/Wastewater Individual Sewage Treatment Systems #1.19 • April 2009

This fact sheet serves as the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency's (MPCA) Warrantied Systems List per Minn. Stat. § 115.55, subd. 9. Local units of government may prohibit or restrict the use of technologies on the Warrantied Systems List.

How is a product added to the Warrantied List?

Products appearing on this list have successfully submitted the following information to the MPCA:

- The product meets all local ordinance requirements.
- The product was designated by MPCA as a warrantied system as of June 30, 2001.
- The product is a modified version of this designation and meets all requirements for the previous classification.
- Documentation showing a minimum of 50 of the products have been installed and operated and are in normal use across all major soil classifications for a minimum of three years.

For each product meeting the above requirements, the product's manufacturer must also provide to the agency:

- documentation of a full warranty effective for at least five years from the time of installation
- a commonly accepted financial assurance document of the manufacturer's or designer's financial ability to cover potential replacement

and upgrades during the warranty period

- reimbursement to the agency of \$2,000 for staff services needed to review the submitted information

Does any additional information need to be provided?

The system manufacturer must also provide to the local unit of government:

- reasonable assurance of the product's performance
- the engineering design of the product
- a monitoring plan that will be provided to system owners
- a mitigation plan that will be provided to system owners describing actions to be taken if the product fails

Can products be prohibited from the Warrantied List?

The MPCA may prohibit a product from qualifying for installation upon discovery of fraud, product failure, failure to meet warranty conditions, or failure to meet statutory requirements. Prohibition of installation of a product by the commissioner does not alter or end warranty obligations for systems already installed.
