## Instructions for Form TM-01

- 1a) **AQ Facility ID No.** -- Fill in your Air Quality (AQ) Facility identification (ID) Number (No.). This is the first eight (8) digits of your permit number.
- 1b) **AQ File No.:** -- Fill in your Air Quality File Number, if known. This is the number often seen in the "cc" section of correspondence from the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency (MPCA).
- 2) **Facility Name** -- Enter your facility name.
- 3) **Was air dispersion modeling required as a condition of your current Part 70 permit?** -- This requirement would be listed in Table B of your permit, under "Total Facility." If the answer is "no" skip to question 6.
- 4) **Was the required air dispersion modeling completed?** -- Indicate if the modeling was completed, or if not, why. (There may be cases where the requirement was waived.)
- 5) **Were any physical changes made to the facility because of the modeling results, or are any changes to the permit still required?** -- Indicate if you made any physical changes to the facility because of modeling results (for example, raising the height of a stack), or if the modeling results triggered changes to the permit that have not yet been made (if the change was already described on another form, please reference that here).
- 6) **Was performance testing (stack testing) required as a condition of your current Part 70 permit?** -- The testing requirement would be listed in Table A, and could appear multiple times in many locations. If the answer is "no" then you are done with this form.
- 7) **Was the testing completed?** -- Indicate if the testing was completed, or if not, why. (There may be several reasons for non-completion of testing, including extension requests approved by the MPCA, or removal of the equipment to be tested.)
- 8) **Are there any changes to the permit required as a result of this testing?** -- This refers only to required changes that have not yet been made. If the test results require that changes be made to the permit, and those changes have not yet been made (they do not show up in the information we sent you on the colored sheets), please indicate the date(s) of the test report(s) containing these results. If the change has already been described elsewhere, then indicate that here as well.
