Instructions: To qualify for the ambient air quality standard applicability exemption, the following notification must be completed and submitted to the County Feedlot Officer (CFO) or appropriate Minnesota Pollution Control Agency (MPCA) staff person. Notifications submitted without all of the required information will not be accepted and will not qualify for said exemption.

***Note:** For facilities having a capacity of greater than 300 animal units, Minn. Stat. § 116.0713, Item C, limits the maximum cumulative exemption for the removal process in a calendar year to 21 days. To maximize available exemption days, be sure to notify the CFO or MPCA when manure removal is temporarily discontinued for any reason, such as in-climate weather, mechanical failures, etc. If in a non-delegated county or you are a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit holder, forward this notice to the MPCA regional feedlot staff.
