Subject: Accepting Projects for State Revolving Fund Loan Programs

Submissions are now being accepted to place public wastewater, stormwater, and drinking water infrastructure improvement projects on the 2014 Project Priority Lists (PPL) and Intended Use Plans (IUP) for the Clean Water and Drinking Water Revolving Funds. Projects must be listed on the appropriate PPL as the first step to be eligible for the revolving fund loan programs or Clean Water Legacy grants. System owners must request that their projects be placed on the appropriate 2014 Intended Use Plan if they expect to be ready for construction and are seeking financing in state fiscal year 2014 (July 1, 2013 to June 30, 2014).

The two state revolving fund programs are administered by the Minnesota Public Facilities Authority, together with the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency and Minnesota Department of Health. The Public Facilities Authority provides below-market rate loans, principal forgiveness or grants to local governments for eligible projects based on priorities determined by the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency (for wastewater and stormwater projects) and the Department of Health (for drinking water projects).

Deadlines are listed below for the Project Priority List. The Public Facilities Authority deadline for Intended Use Plan submissions is June 7, 2013.
