



## ***Facts about*      The Operator's Summary**

The Operator's Summary repeats all requirements from Table A of your air emissions permit for individual emission units or other portions of your facility. This summary is designed to be helpful to a facility operator. For example, you may want to post the requirements associated with a particular boiler by that piece of equipment.

The Operator's Summary is not part of your permit. However, the requirements listed in the summary are identical to those in your permit.

The Operator's Summary does not include requirements for either Table B (Submittals) or Table C (Compliance Schedule).

Generally, the MPCA believes that these requirements may be handled by a person other than the facility operator. Regulatory citations are also not included, because the intent is to have a concise summary for the operator.

To help you decide you would like the summary with your final permit, the following examples illustrate the format and content of an Operator's Summary. In an actual Operator's Summary, one set of requirements will appear per page. The Operator's Summary is available to all permittees upon request.

### **OPERATOR'S SUMMARY**

**The Operator's Summary lists monitoring, record keeping, and testing requirements for individual emission units or groups of units at the stationary source. Refer to Table B of this permit for all reporting requirements. This summary is designed to be helpful to a facility operator. All requirements listed in the Operator's Summary are listed elsewhere in the permit.**

What to do
Pressure Drop: greater than or equal to 2 inches of water column and less than or equal to 6 inches of water column, recorded once every 24 hours when in operation.

**Subject Item:** SV 005

**Associated Items:** EU 003 Cutoff Saw  
EU 004 Resaw

What to do
Opacity: less than or equal to 20 percent opacity
Particulate Matter: less than or equal to 0.010 grains/dry standard cubic foot

**Subject Item:** Total Facility

What to do
Inspections: Upon presentation of credentials and other documents as may be required by law, allow the Agency, or its representative, to enter the Permittee's premises to have access to and copy any records required by this permit, to inspect at reasonable times (which include any time the source is operating) any facilities, equipment, practices or operations, and to sample or monitor any substances or parameters at any location.
Application for Permit Amendment: If a permit amendment is needed, submit an application in accordance with the requirements of Minn. R. 7007.1150 through Minn. R. 7007.1500. Submittal dates vary, depending on the type of amendment needed.
Circumvention: Do not install or use a device or means that conceals or dilutes emissions, which would otherwise violate a federal or state air pollution control rule, without reducing the total amount of pollutant emitted.
Monitoring Equipment: Install or make needed repairs to monitoring equipment within 60 days of issuance of the permit if monitoring equipment is not installed and operational on the date the permit is issued.
Air Pollution Control Equipment: Operate all pollution control equipment whenever the corresponding process equipment and emission units are operated, unless otherwise noted in Table A.
Fugitive Emissions: Do not cause or permit the handling, use, transporting, or storage of any material in a manner which may allow avoidable amounts of particulate matter to become airborne. Comply with all other requirements listed in Minn. R. 7011.0150.



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
