**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Commissioner of the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency (MPCA) will hold a public information meeting regarding the proposal to issue Air Emission Permit No. 03700368-001 to Recovery Technology Solutions for its facility located at 284th St East, Randolph, Dakota County, Minnesota.

This public information meeting pertains to the air quality permit that the MPCA will propose to issue for the construction and operation of Recovery Technology Solution's facility to recover asphalt from shingles. The draft permit is not available for review and comment at this time. It is anticipated that the draft permit will be available for public comment for at least 30 days beginning in March or early April 2013, prior to the scheduled public information meeting.


