

Quick guide – Nonmetallic mineral processing air emission inventory report

General permittees cover letter

As the owner or operator of a permitted air quality facility, you are required to submit an emission inventory report by **April 1, 2024**. If your facility does not submit an air emission inventory report on time, enforcement action may be taken, and your next annual air fee will include an additional fee.

What do I need to do?

- **1.** Complete the enclosed air emission inventory report for your nonmetallic mineral processing permitted facility.
- 2. Sign and date the report.
- **3.** Make a copy for your records.
- **4.** Return the original report, postmarked no later than **April 1, 2024**, to:

What if there have been changes at my facility?

Submit an administrative change form (GP-01) and submittal cover page (SCP-01) to the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency (MPCA) if any of the following permit changes have been made:

- Facility name.
- Ownership or control of the facility.
- Change in owner's or operator's name.

What if my facility permanently closed?

Submit a Notice of Permit Termination request using MPCA's e-Services at https://rsp.pca.state.mn.us/. Guidance on permit termination can be found at: https://www.pca.state.mn.us/business-with-us/air-permit-application-forms.

What if my facility relocated?

If the facility is a portable plant and has relocated to a location authorized by the existing permit, submit Form NM-RE, Location Notification at: https://www.pca.state.mn.us/business-with-us/air-permit-application-forms. Notify the MPCA each time the facility changes location.
