## **Guidance for Stakeholder Comments**

- 1) Participants from each of the stakeholder groups will be given the opportunity to share their comments on the proposed funding models and other components of the proposed legislation.
- 2) Participants are encouraged to offer creative solutions to address a regional approach to the collection and recycling of electronic waste and, if possible, recommend specific changes to the proposed financing models.
- 3) Participants wishing to speak are asked to indicate their desire to do so prior to the meeting.
- 4) Participants interested in presenting comments are asked to limit their presentations to five minutes.
- 5) Participants are encouraged to coordinate with other stakeholders to streamline presentations and avoid redundant comments.
- 6) The states participating in this initiative are interested in an opportunity to ask specific questions regarding implementation aspects of the proposed financing options. It is expected that at least 15 minutes of the time allotted for each stakeholder group will be devoted to questions and answers. This is also an opportunity for participants to offer comments and suggestions that were not included in their five minute presentations.
- 7) Participants and others who are unable to attend are encouraged to submit written testimony.
