Erosion prevention and sediment control

Perimeter control

Retains sediment on a construction site. Intended to slow and hold flow, filter runoff, and promote the settling of sediment out of runoff via ponding.





Dewatering

The removal of surface or ground water to dry and/or solidify a construction site. Examples include pumped discharges, trenches, and ditch cuts used for drainage.





Covers exposed soils to reduce erosion during rain events or snowmelt. Practices include mulch, erosion control blankets, construction phasing, and horizontal slope grading.
