Who is the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency ?

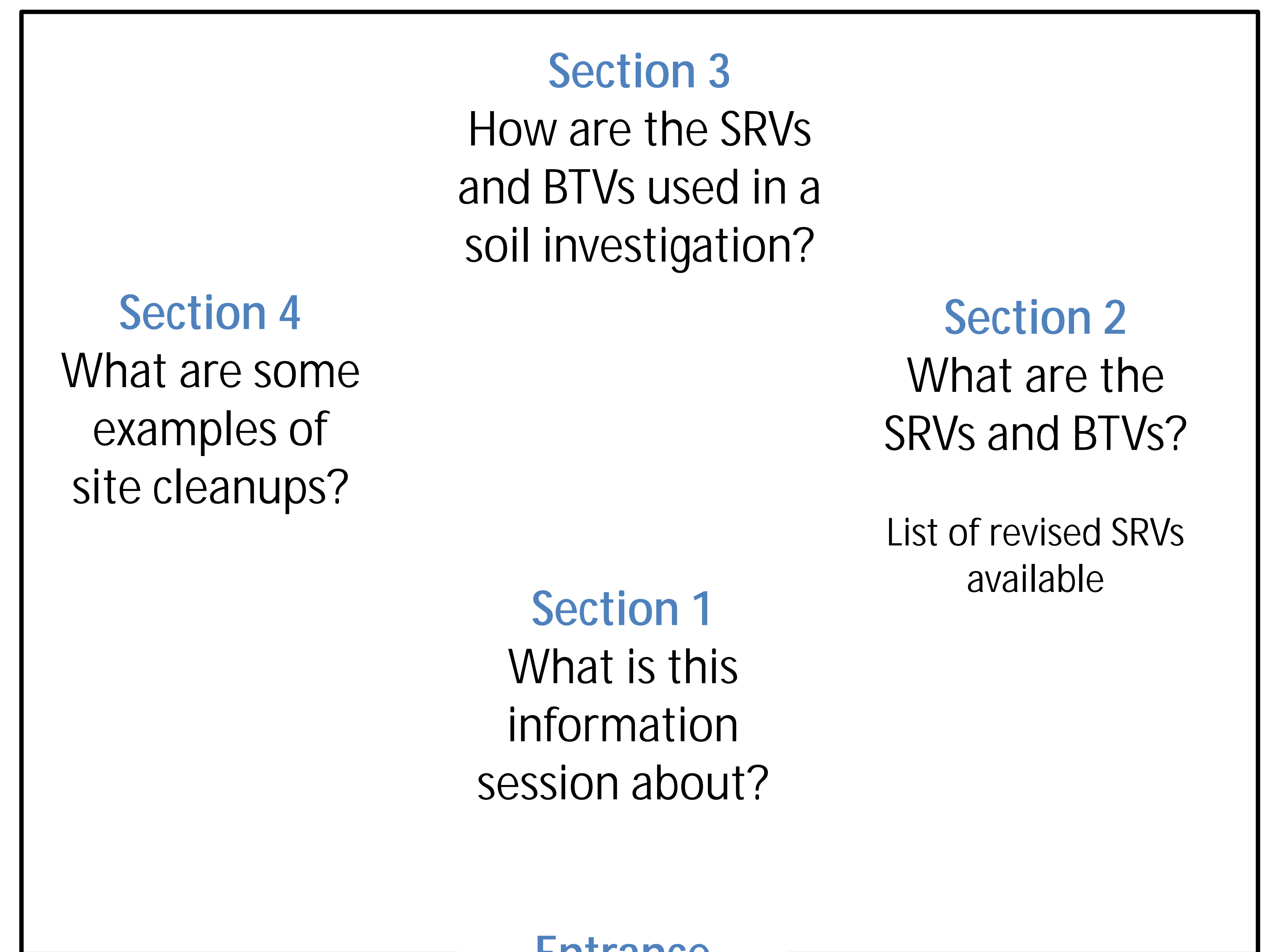
