



The Resource Management & Assistance Division contains the most diverse types of programs at the MPCA, encompassing both regulatory and voluntary functions.

- We provide multimedia technical, compliance, and financial assistance to companies of all sizes.
 - We help prevent and reduce air and water pollution by working with partners in the public, private, and community sectors. Innovative solutions are used to reduce pollution that is generated by unregulated sources.
 - We help to create successful, environmentally-sustainable businesses through product stewardship, market development, preventing pollution at the source, and reducing toxicity and waste in products and in product uses.
 - Rules staff provides project management and rulemaking expertise to programs undertaking administrative rulemaking. We use water quality certification to protect wetlands and other aquatic resources. We conduct financial review of facilities to ensure parties have the fiscal means to operate and properly close sites.
 - Environmental Justice staff strives to ensure that all people — regardless of their race, color, national origin or income — benefit from equal levels of environmental protection and have opportunities to participate in decisions that affect their environment and health.
 - Our Environmental Review process informs decision makers and the public of the potential environmental impacts of proposed projects before final actions and decisions are made, and provides the public with systematic access to government decision makers.
 - The solid waste and land permitting programs cover the life cycle of waste; reducing generation, increasing reuse and recycling, regulating management and disposal, and ensuring compliance. Land permitting includes industrial solid waste, hazardous waste, and aboveground storage tanks.
