Dear Committee Chairs and Minority Leads:

Minn. Stat § 14.116 (a), states:

“By January 15 each year, each agency must submit its rulemaking docket maintained under section [14.366](#), and the official rulemaking record required under section [14.365](#) for any rule adopted during the preceding calendar year, to the chairs and ranking minority members of the legislative policy and budget committees with jurisdiction over the subject matter of the proposed rule.”

The Minnesota Pollution Control Agency (MPCA) hereby delivers to you a hyperlink to the rulemaking record for the following rules we completed in 2020, and a hyperlink to the MPCA Rulemaking Docket:

- Adopted Permanent Rules Governing Federal Performance and Other Air Quality Standards, Minn. R. chs. 7005, 7007, 7011, 7017, and 7019, Revisor’s File Number R-04452, effective March 23, 2020.

- Adopted Permanent Rules Governing State Disposal System Permits and Sewage Treatment Systems, Minn. R. chs. 7081 and 7082, Revisor’s File Number R-4478, effective January 11, 2021.
