

Coordinated Project Plans – Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) timelines

EIS steps for a Mandatory or Voluntary EIS

- 1. Identify challenging issues for the Coordinated Project Plan (CPP).
- 2. The Project Proposer requests CPP.
- 3. Within 60-days of request for a CPP, the CPP is prepared. The CPP covers the scoping process through a final scoping decision.
- 4. The Minnesota Pollution Control Agency (MPCA) prepares a scoping Environmental Assessment Worksheet (EAW) and Draft Scoping Decision Document (DSDD).
- 5. The MPCA distributes the EAW and the DSDD for public comment.
- 6. The MPCA hosts a public scoping meeting.
- 7. The MPCA prepares a Final Scoping Decision Document (FSDD).
- 8. The MPCA issues the FSDD.
- 9. Within 60-days of the FSDD, update the CPP to include the remainder of the EIS process.
- 10. The MPCA issues an EIS preparation notice.
- 11. The MPCA drafts the EIS.
- 12. The MPCA distributes the draft EIS for public comment.
- 13. The MPCA holds an informational meeting.
- 14. The MPCA finalizes the EIS.
- 15. The MPCA distributes the final EIS for public comment.
- 16. The MPCA determines the adequacy of the final EIS.
- 17. The MPCA distributes an adequacy decision.

Note: CPP requires the decision on the adequacy of the EIS to be made no later than 4-years after the submittal data for the EAW is deemed complete by the agency.

EIS steps for a Discretionary EIS

- 1. The MPCA makes a positive EIS Need Decision for a project following the preparation of an EAW.
- 2. Identify challenging issues for the CPP.
- 3. The Project Proposer requests a CPP.
- 4. Within 60-days of request for a CPP, the CPP is prepared. The CPP covers the scoping process through a final scoping decision.
- 5. The MPCA hosts a public scoping meeting.

- 6. The MPCA prepares a Final Scoping Decision Document (FSDD).
- 7. The MPCA issues the FSDD.
- 8. Within 60-days of the FSDD, update the CPP to include the remainder of the EIS process.
- 9. The MPCA issues an EIS preparation notice.
- 10. The MPCA drafts the EIS.
- 11. The MPCA distributes the draft EIS for public comment.
- 12. The MPCA holds an informational meeting.
- 13. The MPCA finalizes the EIS.
- 14. The MPCA distributes the final EIS for public comment.
- 15. The MPCA determines the adequacy of the final EIS.
- 16. The MPCA distributes an adequacy decision.

Note: CPP requires the decision on the adequacy of the EIS to be made no later than 4-years after the submittal data for the EAW is deemed complete by the agency.
