### Goals for this grant round

- Increase local demand for recyclable material
- Create stable, local markets for recyclable material
- Divert materials from disposal
- Create Jobs in Minnesota



# \$400,000 in Total Grant Money

- Maximum Grant is \$200,000
- Minimum Grant is \$50,000
- Requires a 25% match with cash or in-kind work

Example: Asking for \$60,000 requires a \$15,000 match

 This is a reimbursement grant – costs are paid upon approval of submitted invoices

### Priority Materials – Receives 10 evaluation points

- Mixed Paper
- Glass
- Organics (includes food waste, food-soiled paper products, and compostable food serviceware accepted at industrial compost facilities)
- PET plastic
- Plastic Film (includes retail bag film, pallet wrap film, ag plastic and boat wrap)
- \*\*Any type of Recyclable Material will be considered

### Eligible Applicants

 Businesses located in Minnesota, have a facility located in Minnesota, or that will locate a business in Minnesota

- Non-profits organizations
- Colleges and Universities
- Local Units of Governments
- Economic Development Districts



## Eligible Projects – What are we looking for?

 Use recyclable material to make new products or expand existing products

Processing recyclable material into a higher value to use in making a

product







### This could include:

- Research, development, and testing of new products using recyclable material as a feedstock
- Research, development, and testing of existing products to use recyclable materials that currently use virgin materials as a feedstock
- Expand existing capacity to make recycled-content products
- Processing or production methods that add value to a recyclable material
- Equipment (other than rolling stock) to help process and handle material
- Facilities to process organic material into a product such as compost or biogas and digestate
- Leasehold improvements that are needed to install new, refurbish, or upgrade equipment
- Modifying an existing building in order to address a capacity problem to process more material. This
  excludes storage space.

### Ineligible Projects

- Projects that do not use recyclable material as a feedstock
- Projects that do not process recyclable material
- Projects that turn recyclable material into liquid fuel
- Projects that solely focus on product/material reuse
- Would be located outside of Minnesota



### Ineligible Costs – Refer to list in RFP

- Marketing plans only
- Rolling Stock Trucks, cars, vehicles





- Real property defined as land and any property attached directly to it
- Costs incurred before the grant agreement is signed



### Evaluation – Exhibit A attached to the RFP

This will tell potential grantees the points available for each category evaluated.

#### Example:

Need for the project: The project will add value to the recycling markets in Minnesota. Will the proposed project 1) Create demand for a recyclable material that is of low market value. 2) Processing recyclable material into a higher value to use in making a product. 3) A material that is could be recycled but is currently being disposed of as garbage. (25 points)

### Environmental Justice – 5 Points

- Prioritize projects that serve and improve communities with higher concentrations of low-income residents and people of color, including tribal communities.
- Applicants will describe how their organization or project will make sure
  people in the project area and community aren't disproportionately impacted
  by pollution regardless of their race, color, national origin or income, and are
  provided access and opportunity to a clean environment.

• Deadline is Friday January 8, 2021, at 4pm. No late proposals will be accepted.


- Must include:
  - Application
  - Workplan and Budget
  - Optional: Letters of Support and Vendor Quotes
- NEW: Must submit through SWIFT

### SWIFT Terminology & Things to Know

- The RFP is labeled an Event in SWIFT.
- Bidding = Applying
- The Supplier Portal is "homebase" for navigating to find the RFP, applying or bidding on the RFP, and resources for questions and information.
- You do not need any credentials/log-in information for viewing the RFP, application, etc.
- You will have to register as a bidder to apply or bid.



- Awarus, maximum 3200,000, minimum 330,000
- Match requirement: 25% (applicants must provide at least 25% match of the grant award)

#### Application process

The RFP and application materials can only be accessed and submitted though the online SWIFT Supplier Portal under "Bidding opportunities." More information can be found under "Informational Tips" and "Supplier Portal Help."

### How to Apply in SWIFT


- In order to apply or bid on the RFP, you must register as a bidder.
- Go to the Supplier Portal Page and click on Register for an Account.



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
### Registering as a Bidder
