

Order Adopting Rules

Minnesota Pollution Control Agency

Adoption of Rules Relating to the Dry Cleaner Environmental Response and Reimbursement Account (Dry Cleaner Account Rules), Minnesota Rules, Chapter 7152; Revisor's ID Number 4959, CAH Docket Number 5-9003-41437

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

1. All notice and procedural requirements in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 14, Minnesota Rules, chapter 1400, and other applicable law have been complied with.
2. The agency received no written comments and submissions on the rule. Zero persons requested a public hearing. Therefore, there are not 25 or more outstanding requests for a public hearing. The agency received 0 requests for notice of submission to the Court of Administrative Hearings.
3. Minnesota Statutes, section 115B.50, subdivision 4, authorizes the commissioner of the Pollution Control Agency to make the following rule changes:
 - A. Amend Minnesota Rules, part 7152.0500, subpart C, to delete existing maximum hourly rates and replace them with updated rates.
 - B. Amend Minnesota Rules, part 7152.0600, subpart C, to delete existing maximum per diem cost and replace it with an updated rate.
4. Minnesota Statutes, section 115B.50, subdivision 4, authorizes the use of the expedited rulemaking process for these rule changes.
5. The rules are needed and reasonable. The adjustment in rates to allow for economic inflation or deflation creates a means to reimburse owners and operators for the cost of response actions, such as the cleanup of soil, groundwater, and soil vapor contamination, resulting from dry cleaning facilities as intended in Minnesota Statutes, section 115B.50.

ORDER

The above-named rules, in the form published in the State Register on January 5, 2026, are adopted under my authority in Minnesota Statutes, section 115B.50, subdivision 4, and the Administrative Procedure Act, Minnesota Statutes, section 14.389.
