Proposed Process for FY24-25 Funding Proposals as of 15 Nov 2021 October 2021 to January 2022

- Council gathers high-level input from stakeholders

February 2022 BOC meeting

- Council provides strategic direction/priorities to agencies

March 2022

- BOC meeting: Agencies & BOC discuss strategic direction/priorities
- Agencies submit proposals
- Full Council meeting: Brief overview of Research & Evaluation projects

April 2022

- BOC Meeting: Agencies present detailed proposals on Research & Evaluation
- Full Council: Brief overview of Monitoring & Assessment projects

May 2022

- BOC Meeting: Agencies present detailed proposals on Monitoring & Assessment
- Full Council (two meetings, as was done in 2020): Brief overview of Implementation and Planning projects (One Watershed One Plan, Watershed Restoration and Protection Strategies, Drinking Water/Ground Water, non-point implementation, point source implementation)

June 2022

- BOC Meeting: Agencies presented detailed proposals on Implementation and Planning

July 2022

- Draft BOC recommendations reviewed, discussed
- Stakeholder input requested and presented at Council meeting

August 2022

- Final recommendations approved, transmitted to Governor's office

October 2022

- Final deadline for agency budgets to Governor's office (allowing for possible changes since August)

December 2022

- Legislative deadlines for Clean Water Council recommendations
