Annual report requirements

The 2018 Annual Report is due by March 31, 2019.

The form is available online, or you may request a paper copy by calling the Stormwater Hotline: 651-757-2119 or 800-657-3804 (non-metro only).

To complete and submit the Annual Report form:

- MS Word:** Download the form at: <http://www.pca.state.mn.us/index.php/view-document.html?gid=11281>
 - Go to the "File" tab and select "Save As" to save the form to your computer
 - Complete **all** the questions
 - Keep a copy for your records
 - Send a copy to MPCA as an email attachment to: iswprogram.pca@state.mn.us
 - Make sure you include "2018 Annual Report" in the email subject line
 - If submitting a hard copy by mail, send to the street address listed on the form

 - Click on the "Computer Disk" icon to save the form to your computer
 - Complete **all** the questions
 - Keep a copy for your records
 - Send a copy to MPCA using one of these methods
