A blue-green algae bloom may be present. Blue-green algae can produce toxins that can make people and animals sick.

Avoid water that looks like this:



is discolored or streaky



looks like spilled paint or pea soup



has floating scum, globs, or mats



has small green dots floating in it



- Don't swallow lake water or touch foam, scum, or algal mats.
- Don't let pets swim in scummy water or lick algae off their fur.
- Rinse fish with fresh, clean water and throw away guts before cooking and eating.
- Don't swim in areas where you cannot see your feet in knee-deep water.
